**Who can nominate?** Supervisory administrators or Cahn Fellows Alumni with knowledge of the applicant's leadership ability and student impact.

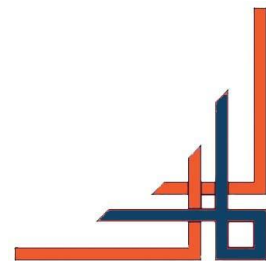
**May I nominate more than one principal?** You are welcome to nominate as many eligible principals as you wish.

The Urban Education Leaders Program (UELPL) at Teachers College, Columbia University is an executive education-style Ed.D. program that convenes for two weeks in the summer and one weekend per month during the regular academic year. In addition to coursework, case studies and field-based experiences, our structured approach to scaffolding the dissertation process provides the support and advisement working professionals need in order to complete their doctoral studies in a timely manner.
