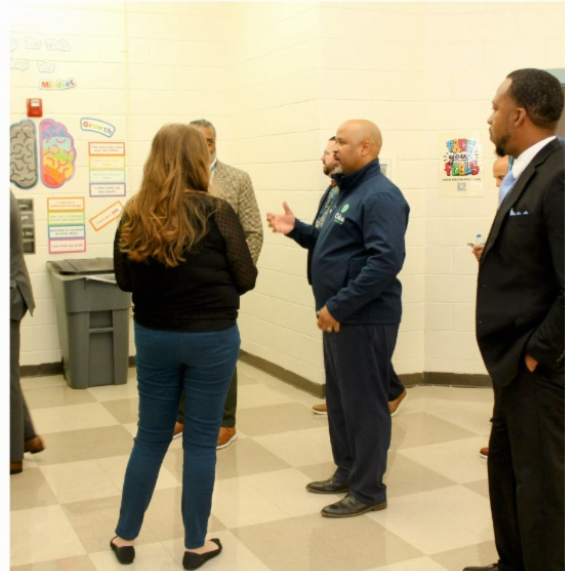
Leadership Lab Corner

The Cahn Leadership Lab (CLL) has 3 major components: Instruction/Presentations on Design Thinking and aspects of adaptive change in schools, School Visits, and Leadership Coaching. Our Leadership Lab principals have completed school visits in Atlanta, New York, and Tampa. The principal practitioners have reported it as a highly impactful part of the Cahn Leadership Lab experience.

Aside from seeing innovative practices at work, our principals appreciate school visits because they hear lessons learned from a successful practicing principal, see and hear the struggles and processes to get to their success, and see schools different from theirs to help them step outside their comfort zone and envision new and different ideas for students.

Nominations for the 2025 cohort open in August. We currently have principals in Atlanta,
